- Proverbs 10:21 – The lips of the righteous feed many, but fools die for lack of sense.
- Proverbs 11:11 – By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted, but by the mouth of the wicked it is overthrown.
- Proverbs 12:6 – The words of the wicked lie in wait for blood, but the mouth of the upright delivers them.
- Proverbs 12:13 – An evil man is ensnared by the transgression of his lips, but the righteous escapes from trouble.
- Proverbs 12:18 – There is one whose rash words are like sword thrusts, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.
- Proverbs 12:25 – Anxiety in a man’s heart weighs him down, but a good word makes him glad.
- Proverbs 13:3 – Whoever guards his mouth preserves his life; he who opens wide his lips comes to ruin.
- Proverbs 14:25 – A truthful witness saves lives, but one who breathes out lies is deceitful.
- Proverbs 15:1 – A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
- Proverbs 15:4 – A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.
- Proverbs 16:24 – Gracious words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the body.
