NEW YEAR REFLECTIONS MESSAGE FROM PASTOR NATE

Dear BBC Family,

Another new year. The calendar continues to change as we finite humans mark linear time, contrasting with God existing for eternity, with no need to measure time. We use these measures of time to navigate and reflect on our lives, to remember big events, to adjust course, to mark out time to rest our frail frame.

These are the things we do as we mark a new year. As I reflect on the ministry of BBC over the past year, I have a couple of highlights and reflections I wanted to share in regards to the ministry of BBC and our mission— *to know Christ, and make Him known*.

First off, praise God for the baptisms of the last year. What a joy it is to symbolically welcome new people into the family of God, as we witness to others that we are new creations, as Paul writes in his second letter to the Corinthians, *Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.* (5:17) What a beautiful thing! But new creation, new beginnings, need care and tending in order for growth to happen. We need intentional discipling, to live with and walk with those who are further on their own journey. This is something we can continue to grow in, outlining this process and equipping people to do this good work.

Second, I remember the driving force behind all the ministry we do as a church, prayer in the Spirit and His outworking of power. This is not just a way to fill a gap, or an obligation to start a meeting, but it is communing with our creator, our Savior, and our King! Many prayers of the saints throughout the last two thousand years have resulted in God's name being made greater and greater for His glory and by His will. How can we as a church be more intentional in this part of our ministry life?

Lastly, we rest in Him. Slow down. Rest in the assurance that *while we were still* sinners Christ died for us (Rom. 5:8). He came once to rescue us, He will come again to bring his final and ultimate rescue for His people. So don't worry about the future, don't strive for things of this world, but only rest in Him, He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? (Micah 6:8)

As Marilyn mentioned during the Christmas Eve candlelight service, God desires us to be more childlike. Why? One reason is that children live in the moment. I admire that trait and strive to be more childlike this year! I've learned so much from the kids. They are eager to share their stories with you. They laugh when they run. They enjoy making adults laugh. They enjoy learning about Jesus and reading their Bibles!

Our Awana Sunday school program continues to have the highest number of participants, with an average of 30-35 kids each week. ImagoKids and Children's curch has 17-21 kids each week. The nursery is bursting with infants, toddlers and preschoolers!

<u>Upcoming</u>

Children's Church: We will focus on the life of Jesus using the Go! Curriculum ("Pixel Party!")

Imago Kids: We will be learning more about Daniel and how we can trust and obey God no matter what happens. We are using The Biggest Story curriculum by Crossway.

We offer a variety of curricula and teaching styles to engage with the kids. Scripture is always the focus. How we share and teach Scripture varies by program. We play running games and have craft time during Imago Kids, whereas Children's Church tends to be non-running games and coloring sheets and word puzzles. AWANA is focused on scripture memorization.

Here's to 2024, being more child-like and eagerly anticipating all of the surprises God has waiting for us!
