MESSAGE FROM PASTOR NATE

Dear BBC Family,

As I sit to write these words on the heels of the annual meeting, I reflect about all the conversations that were had and the conversations undoubtedly many wished to have. The meeting made clear that we all realize the enormous opportunity we've been given and the honor of the task that is set before us by our Lord and Savior, the great commission (Matt. 28:18-20).

Over and over God has laid on my heart that we must continue to seek unity. It's not assumed in the New Testament, but it is sought. We (myself included) must day in and day out seek the Lord's will for us to be part of knowing Christ, and making Him known.

This is no easy task, because sometimes we humans often pray for our will to be done — we easily get tunnel vision and, to be fair, oftentimes on things that are very godly and biblical. We must diligently seek to be unified in the main thing, praying that God would help us to seek unity for the mission He has given us.

So I ask you, will you pray each day that more in our community would come to know Christ more and make Him known? Don't try to fill in the tangible bits, just sit with praying the big vision of Becker Baptist Church. This is the reminder I needed. I pray that it will be encouraging to you as well.

May Becker Baptist seek unity together, until Becker (and the surrounding communities) love Jesus.

MESSAGE FROM CISSY HORSTMAN

VBS 2024 planning is underway! Last year we had 133 kids register and more than 60 volunteers. Becker Evangelical Free Church (BEFC) is partnering with us again this year. We will host a 4-day program and use the Lifeway curriculum. This year the theme is Breaker Rock Beach and the main verse is Romans 12:2. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Please prayerfully consider ways you are able to serve the kids July 15-18, 2024!

The following is from David Rausch who is the author of the *Go! Curriculum* we use in Children's Church.

"4 Tips for leading a Kid to Christ

Avoid coercion. Most kids have the desire to please adults. Avoid language that might pressure a kid into a disingenuous decision to follow Jesus. It's okay to present opportunities by asking questions like, "Do you ever think about asking Jesus to be your Savior?" But allow them to reach a conclusion on their own. In other words, lead them towards a decision; don't push them towards one.

Use the ABCs. There's no formula or magic words for becoming a Christian, but the "ABC's" of salvation are a good way to help kids pray the salvation prayer. It goes like this: "A"—Admit you have sinned and ask God for forgiveness. "B"—Believe that God has sent His son, Jesus, to die for your sins. "C"—Choose to follow Jesus and make Him the leader of your life.

Prompt the child in prayer. It's important that the salvation prayer comes from the heart of the child. Instead of having a kid repeat the prayer after you, provide prompts and let them do the praying. For example, begin by opening the prayer, but then prompt the kid to "admit" they've sinned and ask God for forgiveness. Pause for the kid to say his own prayer and then prompt them through "believe" and "choose."

Celebrate! This is the greatest decision anyone could ever make and it's worth celebrating! Let kids know that all of heaven is rejoicing over their decision. If the kid doesn't have a Bible yet, you might consider buying one for them as a celebration gift. Be sure to share the news with their parents, leaders, or any other people who are important in the life of the child."

The new series for Children's Church in Feburary are "Mixed Up Max" for age 4-Gr. 2 and "Freeze Frame" for Gr. 3-5. We meet at 10:30am every Sunday on the lower level, except for the 1st Sunday of each month when families worship together in the sanctuary for "Family Sunday".

When Jesus was on earth, he wasn't exactly known for telling people what they wanted to hear. Jesus' message was unlike any message people had ever heard before. He didn't give shallow motivational speeches or feel-good sermons. He didn't recycle the same messages other religious leaders were teaching. He flipped people's ideas about God, the world, and themselves completely upside down usually in uncomfortable ways. And that's always how God's words have worked! In this series, we'll compare Jesus' words in the Gospels with the words of the Old Testament prophets to see how God's words have always challenged our understanding of what's wrong or right, good or bad, and just or unjust. We'll talk about how, both then and now, God flips our assumptions about who God values, our definition of righteousness. our understanding of what's good enough, and our definition of justice.
